Esteemed brothers,

Since our last report to Synod Lincoln 1992 we, as address church for the Canadian Reformed Churches in Canada, received and responded to the following correspondence:

- 1. During the years 1992 through 1994 we received requests for data on the Canadian Reformed Churches for the "Yearbook of American and Canadian Churches". Each year we have supplied the pertinent information.
- 2. In October of 1993 and 1994 we were requested to supply updated information for the "Handboek ten dienste van De Gereformeerde Kerken in Nederland" re: "Deputaten Generale Synode". The updated information was submitted right away.
- 3. In September of 1994 we received a request from "Religion Research Bureau" of Arlington, TX. for a copy of our most recent Church Directory. A copy of the 1994 Yearbook of the Canadian and American Reformed Churches was sent on Oct. 17, 1994.
- 4. In December of 1993, Jack Vanderveen of Houston, B.C., requested Acts of General Synod 1954, 1958, 1962, 1971 and 1977. On Feb. 25, 1994 we sent him a copy of all the requested Acts except 1962 for which no extra copy was available. As stated in his letter dated March 10, 1994, Jack Vanderveen plans to scan all the Acts onto computer disc and make them available upon request. (Spe under Archives)
- 5. Letters were received from Rev. Glenn E. Schaeffer of Fort Wayne, Indiana, in December of 1993 and March of 1994, requesting information for his Doctor of Missiology studies. We complied with his request as much as we were able.
- 6. In January of 1994 a letter was received from Dennis R. Hoover of Philadelphia, PA, requesting information about the Canadian and American Reformed Churches for his D.Phil. Politics studies. A letter dated Feb. 2, 1994, providing the requested information, was sent.

All the correspondence we received and mailed out is included with this letter for your perusal and for filing in the Archives of General Synod.
