

-Re: General Fund-

Attached please find a report of Br. Gerry Vandersluis who has taken care of the General Fund on behalf of the consistory at Carman for the last while. The consistory appointed Br. Gerry Vandersluis to take the place of Br. Henry Veldman who has moved away from Carman. With the change over of book-keepers two members of the consistory were appointed to audit the books. This audit was made in mid December 1988 at which time the books were found to be in good order. The books were again audited by two members of the consistory on March 25, 1989 and again the books were found in good order.

With thankfulness we can report that all the Churches have paid the requested assessments and as indicated in the report three Churches have a credit. These Churches will be notified about their credit which will be either received as credit toward an up coming assessment or other wise the payment will be returned.

In Article 84 of the Acts of previous General Synod, Carman was requested to "urge the Immanuel Church (Edmonton) as yet to pay the amount in arrears." We are pleased to report that this amount has been received. We were also requested to "obtain information from the Church at Smithville as to whether this church should be credited the amount of \$279.50." This matter has been looked into and straightened out.
