On Aug. 8 '74 the brothers E. Dijkema and H. Oosterveld of "REHOBOTH" church in Burlington (Burl. W.), appointed by the consistory, have inspected the Archives, as expressed in art. 96-10 Acta Synod 1971.

The Archivist, br. K. Vink, of "Ebenezer" church in Burlington (Burl. E.) keeps any thing that belongs to the history of the churches, as all kinds of reports, Synod and Classis Acts, stencils, bulletins, etc. in perfect order. In no time he is able to give all the needed informations. Br. Vink is a real good professional Archivist.

The Acts of Synods Homewood 2954 and 158, Hamilton 1962, Edmonton 1965, Orangeville 1968 and New Westminster 1971 + all reports and stencils are present.

The Archives are stored in a locked steel cabinet, size 7'-3'-14". If only used for Gen.Synod activities it has sufficient room to serve for a century.

The location of these precious documents is not **mannakely** completely fireproof although water in that area abundently flows. It's a very small storage room in the entrance of the ladies washroom.
