3 **Article 47 – Reopening**

16 Committee 1 presented draft 2 of a report on the Standing Committee for the *Book of Praise*  
17 (SCBP) report regarding additional psalms and hymns (8.2.2.1-3) and related submissions from  
18 churches. The report was discussed. The committee took the report back for refinement.

23 Committee 2 presented two questions regarding the CRCA-CCCNA Study Reports on the

25 discussed. The committee took the matter back for further consideration.
